



8 Tips for a Successful Mentoring Relationship

1 Clarify Expectations

Discuss your mentee's goals and what each of you expects from the relationship. Ensure goals are realistic and use the first meeting worksheet for guidance.

2 Set a Schedule

Agree on how often you'll meet and the duration of the mentorship. Don't forget to update profiles with the end date.

3 Get to Know Each Other

Take time to learn about each other's backgrounds, experiences, and interests to build rapport.

4 Actively Engage

Both the mentor and mentee should contribute. The mentee drives the agenda, and the mentor provides guidance. Be open and respectful in your discussions.

5 Maintain Clear Communication

Mentees should schedule meetings 1-2 weeks ahead and send agendas 2-3 days before. Both should provide feedback, advice, and resources when needed.

6 Be Honest and Tactful

Be truthful if something is unclear but remain respectful when opinions differ. A constructive approach is key.

7 Stay Open-Minded

Share ideas, feedback, and resources openly. Focus on growth, and remember feedback is meant to help, not criticize.
