Registered Degree Program



The IFMA Foundation created the Registered Degree Program in 2020. This program gives guidance on educational criteria to institutions that are starting new facility management programs. This may lead to a future Accredited Degree Program qualification and the proper recognition for their efforts and students' work. This education qualification will accelerate new programs for facility management and could lead to a more professionally trained workforce for both the public and private sectors.

UCI University of California Irvine

The Facility Management Certificate Program focuses on design and management of facilities, from concept to installation to long-term efficient use. Students learn about space planning, leadership, construction management and project management.



Ankara University

Ankara, Turkey

The Real Estate Development and Management BSc and MSc Programs are offered by the Department of Real Estate Development and Management with an emphasis on Facility Management.

Scholarship Program

The IFMA Foundation scholarship program has awarded more than US\$1.8 million dollars to more than 600 students since the early 1990s. Recipients receive a cash award and fully subsidized conference travel, registration and participation to IFMA's World Workplace.

The individual scholarships ranging from US\$1,500 to \$10,000 are awarded to undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in facility management or related (built environment) programs.

These are a principal strategy in creating the next generation of FM professionals. The Global Workforce Initiative explores the expansion of scholarship opportunities. High school seniors, associate degree students, working students and veterans are encouraged to apply.
